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School Uniform

Al Sadiq Islamic English School is a school that requires its students to wear a School Uniform. All School Uniform can be purchased from Threads, and further information about expected uniform and how to order it, is available from the school website:

Uniform Rules for All Year groups:

- All students will ensure that they keep their uniform clean, neat, and tidy at all times. Shirts should be tucked in when worn with a jacket or sweater, sleeves, should be rolled down, buttons done up and shoes cleaned.
- School ties should be worn properly with top button closed.
- Please note that jeans, corduroys, and linen are not permitted, nor are cropped trousers or flares; skirts should be at least knee length and not tight, split or ruffled.
- Skirts should be belted properly at the waist and grey or black full-length leggings should be worn underneath.
- Trousers should be belted properly and not worn low on the waist.
- Grey school socks and black leather shoes should be worn only. Ankle socks are not permitted.
- Please note that trainers of any style or colour, and boots or shoes with reinforced toe caps are not permitted, except where needed as part of the curriculum for specified lessons only, e.g., PE. Otherwise, school shoes as mentioned above must be worn at all times.

Headwear and Hair

- Hair, if uncovered, should be one natural colour with no extreme hair styles including tram-lines, spikes, or patterns. Hairstyles which draw attention to the wearer are not permitted.
- Boys' hair should be neatly trimmed, short/mid-length, to ensure that the ears and forehead are not covered. The length of hair should not extend beyond the nape of the neck and it should be well-presented at all times.
- Girls wearing hijabs are only permitted a plain grey hijab (regular uniform), or a white hijab for PE uniform - **always** neatly tied and it should be worn meeting its purpose.
- Girls wearing abaya should wear plain black abaya with no adornments, over the school uniform.

Cosmetics

- Any use of Make-up, cosmetics, body paint and nail polish is not permitted.

Permissible Jewellery for Girls

- Girls are only permitted to wear a single pair of ear studs. No long earrings are allowed. Any other items of jewellery such as rings, necklaces, wristbands, ankle bands and nose pins are not permitted. If found, they will be confiscated.
- No facial / mouth piercings.

Hygiene

- Students should keep nails trimmed regularly.
- Students should ensure that they shower daily and school uniform should be washed regularly.
- Students should wear appropriate deodorants and take personal pride in their appearance at all times.

ALL ITEMS OF UNIFORM SHOULD BE CLEARLY MARKED WITH THE OWNER'S NAME.

HOODIES AND NON-REGULATION ITEMS ARE BANNED AT ALL TIMES.

Equipment

All students must have a school bag capable of being closed with a zip or buckle.

All students must have a pen, pencil, eraser, ruler, geometry set, dictionary, safety scissors, glue stick and if Year 9 and above, a small scientific calculator.

All students should bring a reading book every day.

Mobile telephones, MP3s, iPods and other devices deemed inappropriate for learning are not permitted to be seen on the school site, and if seen will be confiscated in line with the school's policy. Only pre- authorised devices, tablets and/or laptops will be allowed and these should only be used upon request from the class teacher.

Students bringing a mobile phone from home, that is not required or requested by the class teacher, should deposit it in the tray sent to their class. It will be securely stored in the office of their section supervisor and can be collected from the same. However, the school takes no responsibility for loss or damage of these items.

Uniform and Equipment Card

In order to continue to teach our children the importance of self-respect, neatness, organisation and responsibility, all students from Year 4 to Year 11 will be issued with a Uniform and Equipment Card, as shown below:

Students will be responsible for ensuring they have their uniform card available at all times. This will need to be produced when a member of staff requests it, and will be dated and signed whenever a student is found to have breached the rules described above. E.g. shirt is untucked, incorrect shoes are worn, equipment is forgotten etc.

Once a Uniform Card has been completed, it will be collected by the signing member of staff, and given to relevant supervisor for contact to be made home and an after-school detention set as per Behaviour Policy. A new uniform card will be given by the section Supervisor.

Any student who loses or cannot produce their Uniform Card will be deemed to have completed it and will serve the above detention. There will be no excuses permitted -this will ensure that students learn to be responsible for their own uniform and equipment, thus supporting them in being organised and ready to work.

All Uniform Cards will start afresh at the beginning of every half-term. Any student who has a 'clean' card at the end of the mid-term will have their cards collected and will be entered into a Prize Draw to be held by the Principal at the beginning of the next mid-term. It is therefore in the best interest of the student to ensure that they never collect any signatures on their card. Only cards with NO sanctions or signatures will be entered into the draw.
